## TODAY'S ANTHEM

### For the Fallen

Text: Laurence Binyon; Music: Mike Sammes

They shall grow not old, as we that are left grow old:

Age shall not weary them, nor the years condemn.

At the going down of the sun and in the morning

We will remember them.

### About the Anthem:

The text is taken from a longer poem by English poet Laurence Binyon, and is frequently used at ceremonies commemorating those who died in wars over the last century. Binyon wrote this very early in the war, and it was published in "The Times" in September of 1914, before the monumental trench battles of the next four years.

English composer Mike Sammes has written a beautifully simple melody to the text, and the anthem ends with a poignant trumpet repetition of the final measures of "The Last Post".
