The Anthem this Week

The Ensemble will sing a piece originally performed by the Swedish Vocal Jazz ensemble "The Real Group". The melody comes from Dalarna, a region of Sweden best known for their brightly colored carved horses. The Real Group was founded in 1984 by five students at the Royal Academy of Music in Stockholm, and they have since been recognised as one of the foremost Jazz ensembles of their generation.

The arranger of the piece, Margareta Jalkeus, is a member of The Real Group. It starts with the melody sung by the altos, and then gradually builds into lush melodic and harmonic lines.
