# Actions for "Like a Rock":

**Like a rock:** Extend both forearms upward, palms facing down in one movement. **Like the starry night sky:** Wiggle fingers while slowly raising arms to head height.

Like the sun: Extend one forearm, palm up. With palm down, slowly extend the other hand 6" over

the first arm, arcing up at the end, so the palm is facing away from the body.

Like the river: Leave the first forearm as before. Other hand makes a "swimming" motion close to it,

by weaving it gently in a handshake position.

**Evermore:** End with "God's hug" - crossing arms over chest, hands to shoulders.
